KSD TO RESURFACE MTHATHA NORTH STREETS

The King Sabata Dalindyebo Municipality has officially handed over the contractors tasked to resurface some of KSD Streets. The project which is handed over to Bathabile Construction, has benefited Mthatha residents in terms of job opportunities as a minimum of thirty (30) unemployed community members will now be employed. The project is expected to take a period of nine (9) months starting from the 13th of January to the 13th of October 2016. R22 Million has been set aside for this project.

KSD Municipality has identified four (4) Streets that need to be rehabilitated from Ward eight (8), nine (9) and Ward thirteen (13). The affected Streets are Ncamedlana in 1st Avenue Ward 8, Hillcrest Gerald Hawkes Ward 9, North Crest at Nombembe Street and Cray Fish Crescent at Ward eight (8).

Councillor N.R Gcingca who is also the member of the Mayoral Committee, in her speech she mentioned that the project belongs to the residents and that it is their responsibility to protect the site of the contractor and she further urged the residents to co-operate with the contractor for the smooth running of the project. She also made it clear that the selection of those who will benefit from the job opportunities is the prerogative of the Ward Councillors.
