REMOVAL OF ILLEGAL BILLBOARDS - OUTDOOR (SIGNAGES) ADVERTISEMENTS WITHIN KING SABATA DALINDYEBO MUNICIPALITY

Notice is hereby given to all government departments/entities/businesses people who have erected illegal outdoor advertisements within the King Sabata Dalindyebo Municipality (KSDM) jurisdiction without the approval thereof. Illegal billboards include billboards erected within the privately owned erven as well as billboards erected on the walls of various residential/ business erven in town. The municipality has developed a policy for billboards / outdoor advertising to regulate illegal land uses.

The municipality has identified a number of illegal billboards within the urban and peri-urban areas of KSDM and all illegal billboards/outdoor advertisements must be removed on or before the 30th August 2019. All businesses with legal erected billboards are also expected to submit the proof of approval and the proof of payments indicating that they are in good standing in as far as the payment of the stipulated tariffs. Billboards/outdoor owners including billboards erected on privately owned properties are expected to remove their billboards before the aforesaid dates and failure to remove these billboards within the stipulated time-frame will result in removal of same by the municipality at a cost as stipulated in the policy.

The owners of removed billboards will be fully liable for all the costs associated with this exercise. All owners have the right to formally apply for the erection of the billboards/outdoor advertising from the municipality at a tariff fee approved by Council.
