TWENTY SIX KILLOMETER GRAVEL ACCESS ROAD LAUNCHED

Poor roads have a devastating impact on communities, but that will soon be a thing of the past for Nyokinala residents.

King Sabata Dalindyebo Municipality has put aside R11 494 999,97million for the construction of 26km road with one bridge at Nyokinala Village.

For many years, the residents of the area were experiencing difficulties to access the nearby access road and even the emergency service vehicles were facing challenges to reach Nyokinala villagers.

According to the Municipality's plans, the initial goal of this project is to improve the lives of the Nyokinala residents by ensuring that they get access to health care services, schools and other social services available to them.

About forty five (45) unemployed local people will benefit from this project by getting job opportunities. Furthermore, two (2) subcontractors will be used for construction of minor works such as road signs, side drains, bridge headwalls, etc. About eight (8) SMMEs will also benefit from the project.

The construction project has commenced in mid-July 2019 and is expected to be completed within eight months depending on inclement weather conditions.

During interactions between KSD Local Municipality and OR Thambo District Municipality, it has been agreed upon that water and sanitation will be provided once the construction of the road is complete.
