Requirements:

- Certified copy of Identity documents;
- Certified copy of Technikon/University Academic results;
- Certified copy of Confirmation of Registration for P1/P2.
- Applicants should obtain a letter confirming their proof of residence from their respective Ward Councillors.

 Student must have completed their theoretical studies and be available to attend a compulsory interview on the date that will be confirmed after assessment.

Please note that only Student Technicians /Technologist residing within the King Sabata Dalindyebo Local Municipality jurisdiction will be considered under this programme.
